ScholarWorks @ Georgia State University Advantages



Access

ScholarWorks materials are available to anyone, online, for free! Unlike traditionally published, fee-based journals, no subscription or payment is required.

ScholarWorks is open to search engines, increasing the discoverability of publications uploaded into the system. Research has begun to demonstrate that the more accessible a publication is, the more usage and ultimately citations it receives.



Copyright

When publishing in traditional journals, authors are frequently required to transfer their copyright to the publisher. Most publishers do allow authors to add the pre-formatted version of their article to a repository like ScholarWorks. ScholarWorks does not require any copyright transfer; only a license to post the content.



Preservation

Archived by the University Library, ScholarWorks extends the library's role of preserving scholarly records into the digital age by preserving Georgia State's digital scholarly record for future generations.



Analytics

ScholarWorks provides a monthly readership report to contributors. Information in the report includes number of downloads, search terms that led to the work, and locations where the work was accessed.

Additional ScholarWorks Services

Online Journal Management

ScholarWorks is a hosted repository on the Digital Commons platform. This platform contains a robust professional-grade peer-review / editorial management system for producing, publishing and hosting scholarly publications that have an affiliation with Georgia State University.

Conference Management

ScholarWorks can provide an online space to make conference papers, presentations, and other related materials available for download on the Internet. Local academic and/or professional conferences and smaller gatherings hosted by or associated with Georgia State University are eligible to take advantage of this service, which includes a papers/posters/presentations submission system and online review platform.
