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LIBRARY WEBSITE NOW IN MOBILE BETA!

In a 2010 survey of Georgia State undergraduate students, 71% stated that they owned a handheld device capable of accessing the internet. Given national trends, that number has probably only grown in the last year. The library recognized that mobile access to our resources and services would soon be in demand. So we surveyed the campus about a mobile library website and we have been developing one for a few months now.



Now, we're launching a beta version, so we can get feedback from you before Fall semester begins. When you visit m.library.gsu.edu from a handheld device, it will automatically take you to our mobile site.

The survey provided us with a list of features that you wanted to see first. Here's what you asked for:

- **Computer Availability:** You can easily learn how many computing stations are available on each floor.
- **Library Catalog:** Using the GIL-Find interface, you can search our entire catalog of books, videos & more.
- **Ask A Librarian:** Need help? Ask us in a variety of ways from your mobile device. Call, text, email or get live assistance with our chat service.
- **My Library Account:** Login with your Library ID, Last Name and PIN to access your account. This lists the GALILEO Password, your favorite items, checked out items, holds, recalls, fines and more.
- **Hours & Events:** Just like our regular home page, this displays our hours of operation by day. It also lists our service point hours, as well as the times and locations of special events or classes taking place in the library.

NEW DIGITAL MICROFILM SCANNERS

The library recently added two new ScanPro 2000 microfilm scanners to our services. These machines are located on Library North 1, behind and to the right of the grand staircase. These are compact, durable units that are capable of reading all microfilm types with a high-resolution lens. Best of all, they are easy to use and allow you to scan to print, email or save as a PDF.

DUPLEX

Double-sided printing is now the default setting for all black and white printers in the library. It is both environmentally friendly and saves you money.



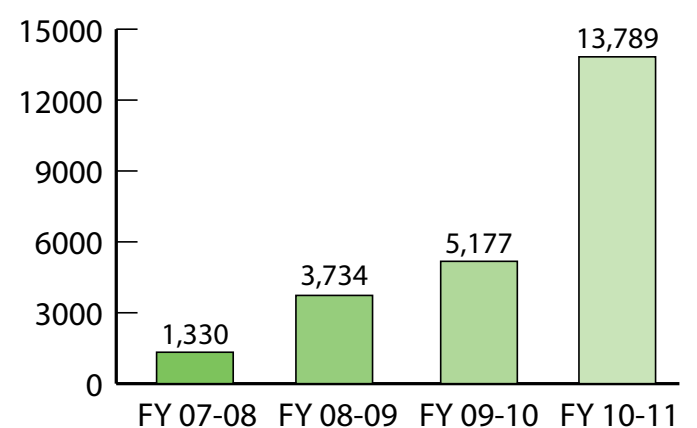
- Double-sided print = 8 cents
- Single-sided print = 5 cents

This setting can be changed in the print preferences for your individual job.








The default setting for the color printer on Library North 2 is still single-sided. You can print duplex on this printer if you adjust the preferences.

- Color Double-sided print = 40 cents
- Color Single-sided print = 25 cents
